Petro Chrypko Memorial Award

In 1991, The Manitoba Parents for Ukrainian Education established the ***Petro Chrypko Memorial Award*** in recognition of academic efforts of students who had entered the English Ukrainian Bilingual Program (EUBP) in 1978 as well as to commemorate the Centenary of Ukrainian Immigration to Canada. These awards, distributed annually continue to support, promote, and acknowledge academic excellence and involvement in the Ukrainian Community.

Attached are two separate applications for the ***Petro Chrypko Memorial Awards*** available this year from The Manitoba Parents for Ukrainian Education. The first award of \$100 will be presented to five qualified graduating candidates. Selection is based on successful completion of the highest level of the English Ukrainian Bilingual Program offered in your school division, as well as the completion of an S4 credit in Ukrainian language obtained through a special language credit examination, a correspondence course, or summer program. The above criteria is also combined with a candidates overall academic achievement, Ukrainian community involvement, and future educational pursuits.

The second award of \$500 will be presented to one qualified graduating candidate who is entering their first year of studies, in a degree program, at an accredited university. This award is available to former EUBP students who plan to pursue a portion of their post secondary education in Ukrainian studies, registering in at least one full credit course in Ukrainian language, history or culture during their first year. The above criteria is also combined with a candidates overall academic excellence and Ukrainian community involvement.

The application submission deadline for all *Petro Chrypko Memorial Awards* is Wednesday July 15, 2009 at 4:00pm. Candidates will be chosen based on all of the above listed criteria by the Manitoba Parents for Ukrainian Education Scholarship Selection Committee.
